

Online Privacy Policy

Personal Information We Collect When You Visit Our Website

- Identifiers, such as your Internet Protocol (IP) address, device identifier, browser, and the URL you came from before you visited our website.
- Information regarding your interaction with our website, including time spent, and engagement with our website and the content on the website.
- Information such as your name, email address and telephone number that you voluntarily provide to us through the “Contact Us” interactive web form on our website.
- Information such as your name, title, company name, email address, telephone number and address when you sign up to receive our newsletter.
- Information that you email to us.

Information We Share With Third Parties

We share your IP address, the URL you came from, and your interaction with the website with analytics providers, third-party advertising networks, and social media platforms for their use in cross-context behavioral advertising across multiple websites. How You May Correct Information Gathered Through Our Website

How Our Website Responds to “Do Not Track” Signals

Do Not Track (“DNT”) is a privacy preference that you can set in your web browser to send a special signal to a website to disable its tracking of an individual user. Currently, there is no universally-agreed upon standard for what a company should do when it detects a DNT signal. Therefore, our website does not respond to DNT signals.

Other Companies May Collect Personal Information About You
